## **SIERRA MADRE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION ANNOUNCES GRANTS**

**SIERRA MADRE, CA Feb. 20:** The Sierra Madre Community Foundation recently awarded the following grants to local organizations:

- The Sierra Madre Public Library received a grant to support its annual One Book One City series. The funds will be used to support a “Human Library” dinner event at the Hart Park House to celebrate this year’s book *HumanKind*.
- The City of Sierra Madre’s Mt. Wilson Trail Race received a grant to purchase T-shirts for its May 25 Kids’ Fun Run. The annual race, open to kids ages 3-13, begins immediately following the start of the Trail Race.
- The Sierra Madre Playhouse received a grant to purchase and install a video monitoring system, part of its venue revitalization program.
- The Sierra Madre Library Foundation received a grant to help furnish the renovated library, when completed.
